


# Tow Line Dimensions



**Note:** For tournament-supplied handle sections, the bridle length shall be 150 cm  $\pm$  2.5 cm (4'11"  $\pm$  1") the triangular portion of the bridle 28 cm  $\pm$  4 cm (11 1/2"  $\pm$  1 1/2"), and the length of the handle 30cm  $\pm$  6 cm (11-13/16"  $\pm$  2-3/8") (see diagram). For skier-supplied handles in the Slalom and Jumping events, the tolerance on the bridle length shall be +2.5 cm/-10 cm (+1"/-4) with no tolerance on the triangular portion of the bridle.

A Slalom Switch or other appliance may be used to attach the slalom towline to the pylon. When so used, that appliance shall be considered a part of the boat/pylon, may be from 0.47 to 0.51m in length, and with a recommended length of 0.50m. The measurements of ropes used with such appliances shall be 0.50m shorter than the values shown in this table.
